BLAINE MARINE PARK

Blaine Marine Park, a charming waterfront park, sits between Drayton Harbor and Semiahmoo Bay on the Salish Sea. Level and easy to navigate, the park is perfect for walking, biking, running, kite-flying, kayaking, fishing, crabbing, playing in a maritime-themed playground, and bird and wildlife viewing. The park consists of several covered and uncovered waterside shelters, walking/biking trails, a marine-themed playground, public fishing pier, a commercial wharf district, and 629 state-of-the-art boat slips for commercial and pleasure boats with a public boat launch.

The harborside of the park has a covered promenade with benches and tables with views over the public marina.

Blaine Harbor Marina is home to the 32-foot Historic Plover Passenger Ferry that runs weekends in the summer from Memorial Day through Labor Day weekend. The Plover shuttles passengers from Blaine Harbor Marina, Gate 2 Visitor's Dock, to Semiahmoo Resort Boat Dock and is part of the Coast Millennium Trail. The ferry is Washington state's oldest operating foot-passenger ferry, listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
